Jessica Alba and Cash Warren are looking for a New York home again. We hear the couple looked at a three-bedroom, three-bathroom, 2,000-square-feet-plus apartment at the 520 West Chelsea last week. Designed by award-winning architect Annabelle Seldorf, the curtain-wall, glass-facade building on W. 19th St. is repped by Emily Beare of Core Group Marketing. The couple reportedly eyed the building's two remaining apartments, one on the seventh floor for \$2.795 million and another on the third floor for \$2.495 million. According to Beare, who wouldn't confirm the two were looking and declined to comment on specifics of their home search, the building has been a home run. "Buyers here understand what this neighborhood will become," she says. "It's close to the High Line and you're surrounded by art galleries. Most people don't believe it, but it's a real family building and neighborhood." Manhattan-based Bishopcourt Realty developed the project.
