

Sax Sells



Star saxophonist David Sanborn, known for his collaborations with David Bowie, the Rolling Stones, Paul Simon, Stevie Wonder, Eric Clapton and other music giants, has put his stunning Upper West Side townhouse on the market for \$12 million.

The 19-foot-wide brownstone at 135 W. 69th St. is fully renovated. It has five bedrooms, three full bathrooms, two half-bathrooms and a separate recording studio on the top floor. There's also a chef's kitchen, four wood burning fireplaces, a terrace and a private garden. Brokers Shaun Osher, Tom Postilio and Mickey Conlon of Core declined to comment.

Sanborn, a six-time Grammy winner, has released 24 albums, with eight going gold and one platinum.
